Application

- Online application system opens 1 November 2023 - Education Online Portal
- National deadline for Year 3 (Junior school) applications – midnight, **Monday 15 January 2024**.
The online application system will close at midnight on this date.
- National notification date – **Tuesday 16th April 2024**. Online applicants will be notified of the outcome of their application by e-mail. They will also be able to log into the online system to view their application outcome.
