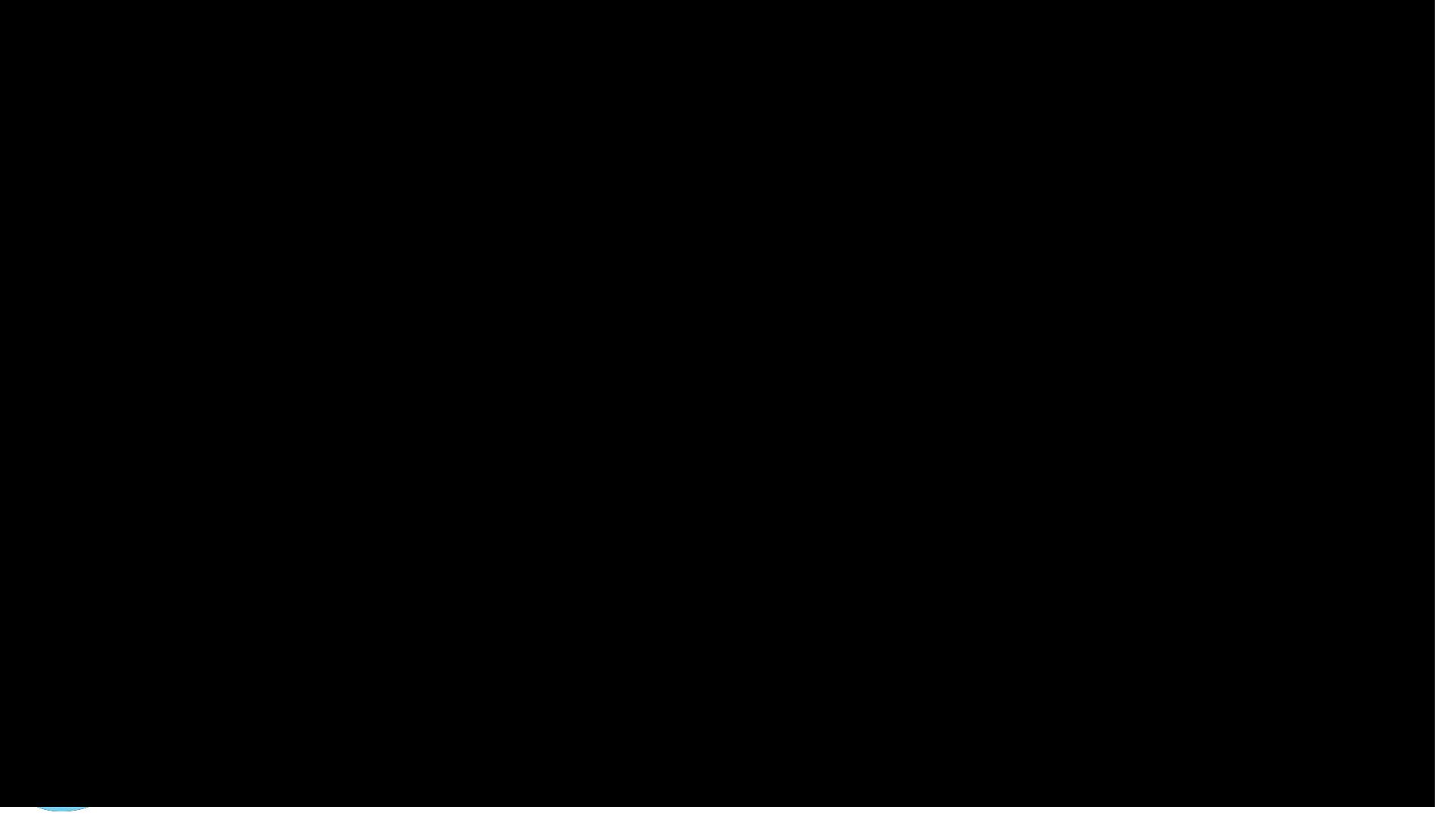

Transition Opportunities

- If you choose King's Academy Gomer your children will have the opportunity to visit us this year on several occasions. This will give them a chance to experience learning at Gomer and to meet their new class teacher and team. Transition opportunities include:
 - 2 visits from Year 3 teachers to see successful applicants in their current infant school
 - A tour for pupils to the junior school in small groups in the summer term
 - Informal activities alongside the juniors e.g. shared playtimes / Gomer fireworks / visits to watch dress rehearsals
 - Allocation of a 'buddy' from year 5, who will be year 6 when they arrive
 - 1 x full transition day in July 2026
 - **FREE** entry to FROJS Summer Disco 2026

Additional transition arrangements will be made for children with additional needs, through our SENCO.

Application

- Online application system opens **1 November 2025** - Education Online Portal
- National deadline for Year 3 (Junior school) applications – midnight, **Thursday 16 January 2026**. The online application system will close at midnight on this date.
- National notification date – **Thursday 16 April 2026**. Online applicants will be notified of the outcome of their application by e-mail. They will also be able to log into the online system to view their application outcome.
